Essay: Pick <b>one</b> of the below topics. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Were European countries justified to set up colonies on land that was already being used? Was it right for them to do? Is there evidence that makes you believe colonization was a good thing to do?</li> <li>• The only clue to the whereabouts of the settlers of Roanoke was the word "Croatian" carved into a tree. What do you believe happened to those settlers?</li> <li>• Tobacco was the main cash crop for the Jamestown Colony. It provided a source of income and trade for early colonists. However, we know that it causes major health problems today. Was it a good idea to plant and grow tobacco in the colonies, or was it a harmful event?</li> </ul> </li> <li>2. Book Talk.
